IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Make Allocations for the Administrative Expenses of the Department of Finance, Bureau of Lottery, for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993.

(EMERGENCY)

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Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

8 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Bureau of Lottery will become due and payable on 10 or immediately after July 1, 1991; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 16 safety; now, therefore,

18 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Allocation. In order to provide for the necessary expenses of operation and administration of the Bureau of
Lottery, the following amounts, or as much as may be necessary, are allocated from the revenues derived from operations of the
State Lottery Fund.

Sec. 2. Allotments required. Upon receipt of allotments duly approved by the Governor, based upon work programs submitted to the State Budget Officer, the State Controller shall authorize expenditures from these allocations on the basis of these allotments and not otherwise.

Sec. 3. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that the allocation of funds by the Legislature, as provided by this Act, applies to the administrative expenses only and that these allocations are allotted and approved under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5. Sec. 4. Adjustments to allocations. Allocations may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Officer with the approval of the Governor, to cover specifically those adjustments determined to be necessary under any salary plan approved by the Legislature and those reclassifications or range changes that have been approved by the Department of Administration and submitted for legislative review prior to the effective date of this Act.

 Sec. 5. Exclusion. Excluding sections 1 to 4 of this Act, up to \$90,000 each fiscal year may be expended for Capital
Expenditures.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect on July 1, 1991.
