An Act to Make Allocations for the Administrative Expenses of the
Department of Finance, Bureau of Lottery, for the Fiscal Years Ending
June 30, 1992 and June 30, 1993.

(EMERGENCY)

2 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
as emergencies; and

4
6 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the
beginning of the next fiscal year; and

8 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the
operation of the Bureau of Lottery will become due and payable on
or immediately after July 1, 1991; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,

18 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20 Sec. 1. Allocation. In order to provide for the necessary
expenses of operation and administration of the Bureau of
22 Lottery, the following amounts, or as much as may be necessary,
are allocated from the revenues derived from operations of the
24 State Lottery Fund.

38 Sec. 2. Allotments required. Upon receipt of allotments duly
40 approved by the Governor, based upon work programs submitted to
the State Budget Officer, the State Controller shall authorize
42 expenditures from these allocations on the basis of these
allotments and not otherwise.

44 Sec. 3. Legislative intent. It is the intent of the Legislature
46 that the allocation of funds by the Legislature, as provided by
this Act, applies to the administrative expenses only and that
48 these allocations are allotted and approved under the Maine
Revised Statutes, Title 5.
