. 20	'1-A. Student election clerks. In addition to the election clerks appointed under subsection 1, the municipal officers may
22	appoint persons who are 17 years of age to serve as student election clerks for a specific election. The student election
24	clerks must be appointed in the same manner as election clerks under subsection 1. A student election clerk may not assist a
26	voter unless the voter specifically requests assistance from the student election clerk.'

30	STATEMENT OF FACT
32	The amendment allows municipal officers to appoint student election clerks who are at least 17 years of age. The political
34	parties would nominate the student clerks, in equal numbers from each party, as required for election clerks under current law.
