Resolve, to Authorize the County of Franklin to Acquire a Certain Parcel of Land in Coburn Gore.



Purchase of Coburn Gore Dump. Resolved: That the County of Franklin is authorized to acquire a certain parcel of land 2 situated in Coburn Gore, consisting of 1.85 acres, more or less, located south of State Highway Number 27 and known as the Coburn Gore Dump Site, on such terms as the commissioners of the County of Franklin determine advisable, including an agreement to 6 release and indemnify the Coburn Gore Partnership, the Van Vleck Family Trust, the Van Vleck Family Partnership and Wagner 8 Woodlands & Co., and their partners, trustees, beneficiaries, officers, directors, employees, heirs, successors, assigns and 10 agents from any and all claims, liabilities or damages that might 12 accrue as a result of the establishment, operation, closure and post-closure maintenance of the landfill located on the parcel while under the control of the County of Franklin. 14

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This resolve authorizes the County of Franklin to acquire a parcel of land known as the Coburn Gore Dump on such terms as the Franklin County commissioners determine appropriate and advisable, including a release and indemnification agreement indemnifying the current owners from any claims, liabilities or damages resulting from the county's operation of the landfill.
