An Act to Allow Supplemental Dependent Life Insurance for State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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5 MRSA §18056, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 801, §§5 and 7, is amended to read:

3. **Dependent insurance.** Each participant may elect to insure the life of a dependent ~~not insured in the group covered under subsections 1 and 2.~~

A. A participant may elect either Plan A or Plan B, but not both.

	Plan A	Plan B
Spouse	\$5,000	\$10,000
Full-time unmarried students to age 22	\$5,000	\$5,000
Children, 6 months to age 19	\$5,000	\$5,000
Children, 0 to 6 months	\$1,000	\$2,500

B. Insurance purchased under this subsection is subject to the limitations of Title 24-A, section 2611-A.

C. The number of dependents may not ~~effect~~ affect the premium rate for insurance purchased under this subsection.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides the opportunity for state employees to purchase at their own expense supplemental coverage regardless of the employment status of spouses.
