COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 781, L.D. 1113, Bill, "An Act to Assist the Expansion of Municipal Sewer Systems"

Amend the bill in section 1, in subsection 2 by striking out all of the 6th and 7th lines from the end (page 1, lines 21 and 22 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following: 'units unless 75% or more of the landowners that will be benefited by the

Further amend the bill in section 1, in subsection 2, in the 5th line from the end (page 1, line 23 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "expansion." and inserting in its place the following: 'expansion'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the bill to increase from 50% to 75% the percentage of the number of landowners who must petition the municipal officers to extend the sewer to benefit their property when they are willing to pay more than 50% of the cost as presently required by law. It deletes provisions giving the same right to the owner or owners of more than 50% of the land that would be benefited.
