COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 412, L.D. 1126, Bill, "An Act to Provide for a Minimum Level of Compensation for Cooperating and Supervisory Teachers of Student Teachers"

Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act:

This bill requires the University of Maine System to increase the compensation of cooperating and supervisory teachers to \$500 per 8-week semester. General Fund appropriations to the University of Maine System of \$581,300 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$581,300 in fiscal year 1992-93 will be required to fully fund this increase to approximately 750 teachers.
