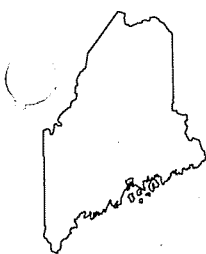

**An Act to Provide for a Minimum Level of Compensation for
Cooperating and Supervisory Teachers of Student Teachers.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20-A MRSA §10909 is enacted to read:

§10909. Compensation; supervisory teachers

The Trustees of the University of Maine System shall provide funding to compensate cooperating and supervisory teachers at a minimum of \$500 per 8-week semester.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Special Commission to Study Teacher Training in the University of Maine System recommended upgraded funding for teachers who work with student teachers in public schools. Currently, cooperating teachers are paid \$150 per semester. This bill increases the compensation for teachers responsible for supervising student teachers to \$500 per semester.
