An Act to Clarify the Laws on Manslaughter in the Workplace.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
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4	17-A MRSA §203, sub-§1, ¶C, as amended by PL 1989, c. 873, is further amended to read:
б	C. Has direct and personal management or control of any employment, place of employment or other employee, and
8	intentionally or knowingly violates any occupational safety or health standard of this State or the Federal Government,
10	and that violation in fact causes the death of an employee and that death is a reasonably foreseeable consequence of
12	the violation. This paragraph does not apply to:
14	(1) Any person who performs a public function either on a volunteer basis or for minimal compensation for
16	services rendered; or
18	(2) Any public employee <u>or employee of a</u>
100 N Star	<u>quasi-municipal corporation</u> responding to or acting at a life-threatening situation who is forced to make and
