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**An Act to Amend Sentences of Imprisonment for Class A Crimes Other  
Than Murder.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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17-A MRSA §1252, sub-§2, ¶A, as amended by PL 1987, c. 808,  
4 §§1 and 3, is further amended to read:

6

A. In the case of a Class A crime, the court shall set a  
definite period not to exceed 40 20 years;

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill decreases the term of imprisonment for a Class A  
crime other than murder from 40 years to 20 years.

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
