×	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	38 MRSA §1310-X, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

б	4. Exemption. A biomedical waste disposal facility is exempt from the prohibitions of this section, if at least 50% of
8	the facility is owned by a hospital or an affiliated interest as defined in Title 22, section 396-L, subsection 1, paragraph A.

	STATEMENT OF FACT
12	This bill exempts hospital-owned biomedical waste disposal
14	facilities from the ban on commercial development of these facilities. To be exempt, the facility must be at least 50%
16	owned by a hospital or by an affiliate of a hospital.
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
