30	The bill created an exemption from the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 2357, which requires
32	quasi-municipal corporations or districts to provide reasonable notice and hearing in accordance with the Maine Administrative
34	Procedure Act before adopting any rule or expanding or creating

That exemption extended to any quasi-municipal any program. corporation or district subject to review by any state agency. This amendment strikes the language of the bill. The amendment creates an exemption for public utilities regulated by the Public Utilities Commission.
