IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Provide for Accountability for Travel Expenses in the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1667, first ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c. 493, §101, is further amended to read:

Not later than June 1st of each year, the Governor shall require the head of each department and agency of the State Government to submit to the Bureau of the Budget a work program for the ensuing fiscal year. Such work program shall must include all appropriations, revenues, transfers and other funds, made available to said that department or agency for its operation and maintenance and for the acquisition of property, and it-shall show the requested allotments of said the sums by quarters for the entire fiscal year, classified to allotments requested for specific amounts for personal services, capital expenditures and amounts for all other departmental expenses. The Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation shall further break down its budget to include institutional food The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife expenditures. shall further breakdown its budget to include travel expenditures. Funds not expended for this these budget item shall items may not be transferred between line categories. The Governor, with the assistance of the State Budget Officer, shall review the requested allotments with respect to the work program of each department or agency and shall, if he-deems-it necessary, revise, alter or change such those allotments before approving the same. The Governor may authorize the State Budget Officer to approve quarterly allotments not to exceed \$500 in any account. The aggregate of such those allotments shall may not exceed the total sums made available to said that department or agency for the fiscal year in question. The State Budget Officer shall transmit a copy of the allotments as approved by the Governor to the head of the department or agency concerned and also a copy to The State Controller shall thereupon the State Controller. authorize all expenditures to be made from the sums available on the basis of such those allotments and not otherwise.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7034, sub-§7-A is enacted to read:

7-A. Report to the Legislature. No later than December 31st of each year the commissioner shall make a report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over fisheries and wildlife matters accounting for the travel expenditures of the department during the preceding fiscal year.
