IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Amend the Laws That Govern Stopping for Certain Approaching Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA §997, as amended by PL 1967, c. 200, is further amended to read: 4

§997. Stop on approaching certain animals

Wheever,-driving-er-operating-a  $\underline{A}$  motor vehicle upen-any-way operator who, when approaching from the opposite direction a person riding, driving or leading a horse or other animal which 10 appeass-to-be-frightened, is signalled by putting up ef-the <u>a</u> 12 hand or by other visible sign by such the person, shall cause such stop the motor vehicle to-come-to-a-stop as soon as possible and remain stationary as long as it may-be is necessary and 14 reasonable to allow such the horse or animal to pass. Whenever traveling in the same direction, the persen-operating-a motor 16 vehicle operator shall use reasonable caution in passing horses 18 or other animals and vehicles.

20 No <u>A motor vehicle</u> operator of-a-motor-vehicle-shall may not operate a motor vehicle in such a manner as to willfully annoy, 22 startle, harass or frighten any animal being ridden er, driven or led in any direction on or near a public way. No A motor vehicle 24 operator or persen-in-a-motor-vehiele-shall passenger may not throw any object or substance from the vehicle toward the animal 26 being ridden er, driven or led.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires motor vehicle operators to stop their vehicles when signalled to do so by a person riding, driving or leading a horse or other animal on a public way and removes the 34 condition that the animal or horse must appear frightened in order for the motor vehicle operator to stop. 36

The bill makes other changes that are not substantive in 38 nature but merely update the law to conform to current statutory 40 language.
