COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 429, L.D. 1150, "Resolve,
to Clear Title to Property in the Town of Oxford"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency
preamble.

Further amend the resolve in that part designated "Authority
to convey." by inserting a new paragraph at the end to read:

'The State's interest must be conveyed for the amount of \$250 to
cover the costs associated with transfer of title. Transfer
documents must be prepared by Richard E. Varney and Barbara E.
Varney for review and approval by the bureau.'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the
emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

Other Funds \$250

This legislation will result in an increase in dedicated
revenue to the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Public
Lands, in the amount of \$250 for fiscal year 1991-92. This
increase in revenue will cover the administrative costs
associated with reviewing the deed and conveying the State's
interest in a parcel of land in the Town of Oxford to Richard E.
Varney and Barbara E. Varney.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause and requires that the petitioning owners of the property, Richard E. Varney and Barbara E. Varney, pay \$250 to cover the costs associated with the transfer of the title and are responsible for the preparation of the transfer documents. It also adds a fiscal note.
