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| | Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the |
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| 2 | Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and |
| 4 | Whereas, Adrien LaMontagne and Germaine LaMontagne have |
| 6 | conveyed their interest in a parcel of land to Richard E. Varney and Barbara E. Varney; and |
| 8 . | Whereas, the parcel makes reference to a right-of-way known |
| 10 | as the "Hadakin Lot"; and |
| 12 | Whereas, the chain of title indicates that the State may have an interest in the right-of-way; and |
| 14 | Whereas, in order to clear title to the right-of-way, the |
| 16 | State's interest needs to be conveyed to Richard E. Varney and Barbara E. Varney; and |
| 18 | Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts |

| 34 | right-of-way to be of sufficient width for two vehicles to use with convenience. |
