An Act to Allow Service of Civil Process by any Licensed Private Investigator or Bonded Security Agency.



2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 14 MRSA §702-A is enacted to read:

6 §702-A. Process by private investigator or bonded security
agency

8 If a sheriff or a deputy sheriff is unable after diligent
10 effort to execute service of a writ or precept required under
12 this subchapter, a private investigator or a bonded security
agency licensed by the State may serve and execute all such writs
and precepts.

16 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill authorizes a licensed private investigator or a
20 bonded security agency to serve and execute civil processes when
22 a sheriff or deputy sheriff is unable after diligent effort to
execute service.
