	not prohibit persons from conducting exit polls or from
10	monitoring voter eligibility inside the polling place.

	STATEMENT OF FACT

	This bill prohibits petitioners and survey takers from
16	conducting their election day activities inside polling places,
	but is not intended to affect monitoring of voters or exit polls.

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
