Amend the amendment in that part designated "§452." in the 18 3rd line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>shall patrol</u>" the following: '<u>, as part of that</u> 20 <u>sheriff's patrol duty.</u>'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The committee amendment, which replaced the bill, requires that the county sheriff patrol areas in the county that have no local law enforcement. This amendment clarifies that a sheriff must include the patrol of such areas as part of the sheriff's other patrol duties.
