HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 813,
L.D. 1167, Bill, "An Act to Ensure that County Sheriffs Continue
to Provide Rural Patrols for Small Towns in the Counties"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§452." in the
3rd line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the
following: "shall patrol" the following: 'as part of that
sheriff's patrol duty.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The committee amendment, which replaced the bill, requires
that the county sheriff patrol areas in the county that have no
local law enforcement. This amendment clarifies that a sheriff
must include the patrol of such areas as part of the sheriff's
other patrol duties.
