HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 813,  
L.D. 1167, Bill, "An Act to Ensure that County Sheriffs Continue  
to Provide Rural Patrols for Small Towns in the Counties"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§452." by  
striking out all of the first sentence (page 1, lines 26 to 29 in  
amendment) and inserting in its place the following: 'The  
sheriff in each county, in person or by the sheriff's deputies,  
may patrol throughout the county, but may not be required by law  
to patrol the entire county. If the sheriff or sheriff's deputy  
does patrol within the county, the sheriff or sheriff's deputy  
must patrol those areas in the county that have no local law  
enforcement.'

This amendment does not require sheriffs or sheriff's  
deputies to patrol within the county; it requires that if a  
sheriff or sheriff's deputy does patrol within the county, the  
sheriff or sheriff's deputy must patrol those areas that have no  
local law enforcement.
