HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 813,
L.D. 1167, Bill, "An Act to Ensure that County Sheriffs Continue
to Provide Rural Patrols for Small Towns in the Counties"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§452." in the
first paragraph in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 27 and 28
in amendment) by striking out the following: "shall patrol those
areas in the county that have no local law enforcement" and
inserting in its place the following: 'to the extent the sheriff
undertakes to patrol, shall patrol those areas in the county that
have no local law enforcement'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that to the extent the sheriff
undertakes to patrol, the sheriff shall patrol those areas in the
county that have no local law enforcement.
