COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 816, L.D. 1170, Bill, "An Act to Make Emergency Changes to the Motor Vehicle Laws"

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "windows" the following: 'that are not replaced in accordance with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 205'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment revises the language of the bill to make it clear that the owner of a motor vehicle with a tinted windshield as original equipment does not need to get a light transmittance certificate when replacing the tinted windshield with another similarly tinted windshield.
