COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 822, L.D. 1176, Bill, "An Act Regarding Vanity Plates for Automobile Dealers"

16 Amend the bill in the first line after the enacting clause
18 (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 1.'

20 Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 1992.

This bill allows new car dealers to receive special initial dealer plates. The additional cost for these plates, \$30 each, will increase Highway Fund revenue by \$6,450 annually. This estimate is based on 215 automobile dealers purchasing the special initial plates.'

This amendment adds an effective date section and a fiscal note to the bill. It makes the bill take effect on January 1, 1992 to make the term of the new car dealer vanity plates consistent with that of other plates issued by the Division of Motor Vehicles.
