An Act Regarding Vanity Plates for Automobile Dealers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 29 MRSA §194, as amended by PL 1987, c. 64, §1, is repealed
and the following enacted in its place:

6 §194. Manufacturers, dealers and transporters

8 1. Special plates. The Secretary of State may select and
10 issue special distinguishing letters, marks or designs for number
12 plates issued to manufacturers, dealers and holders of
14 transporter registration certificates.

16 2. Special initial plates. Upon application, a new car
18 dealer may apply for initial registration plates that may bear
20 letters or combinations of letters and numbers that are approved
22 by the Secretary of State or a designee. A combination may not
24 be duplicated by other licensed vehicle dealers. These special
26 initial plates may not be used to supplement existing
28 registration numbers assigned.

The Secretary of State shall charge an additional \$30 fee per
 plate issued pursuant to this subsection.

 STATEMENT OF FACT

 This bill allows a new car dealer to apply for and receive
special initial dealer plates.
