IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act Relating to Navigation Dredge Maintenance Projects.



	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	38 MRSA §480-U is enacted to read:
4	Secon wastered and sederal newtonian decides estatements
6	§480-U. Municipal and federal navigation dredge maintenance projects
8	Maintenance dredgings of coastal municipal or federal navigation dredging projects approved prior to the effective date
10	of this section by the Federal Government is regulated exclusively by this section regardless of other provisions of
12	this article or any other law.
14	1. One-year notice. An applicant shall notify the commissioner of a proposed maintenance dredging within one year
16 .	of its scheduled undertaking.
18	2. Limited intrusion. The maintenance dredging may not cause additional intrusion into the river, estuary or coastal
20	embayment other than that authorized by the Federal Government.
22	3. Testing. The applicant shall collect and test the dredge spoils in accordance with a protocol approved by the
24	commissioner. The collection, testing and forwarding of the results of the tests to the commissioner must occur within one
26	year before the submission of a notification of undertaking.
28	4. Impact on fishing; suitability. The applicant shall demonstrate that the maintenance dredging, transportation and
30	disposal of dredge material minimizes adverse impact on the fishing industry and that the disposal site is geologically
32	suitable.
34	5. Publication of transportation route. The applicant shall publish notice of the proposed route by which the dredged
36	materials will be transported to the disposal site in a newspaper of general circulation in the areas adjacent to the proposed
38	route.
40	6. Notice to municipalities. Notification must be submitted to each municipality adjacent to any proposed marine
42	and estuarine disposal site and route.
44	STATEMENT OF FACT
46	This bill provides for exclusive regulation of maintenance
48	dredgings of coastal municipal or federal navigation dredging projects approved by the Federal Government prior to the
50	effective date of the bill.
