IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act Concerning Public Representation on Professional and Occupational Boards or Commissions.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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5 MRSA §12004-A, 2nd \P , as enacted by PL 1987, c. 786, §5, is amended to read:

For purposes of any occupational or professional licensing boards which have a public member or members, "public member" means a person who has no financial interest in the profession regulated by the board to which that member has been appointed and who has never been licensed, certified or given a permit in this or any other state for the occupation or profession for which that member is appointed to regulate.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill clarifies that public members of occupational and professional licensing boards may not be licensed, certified or given a permit in this or any other state to promote the profession regulated by the board in this or any other state.

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
