An Act to Increase the Debt Limit of the Kingfield Water District from \$350,000 to \$2,000,000.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as fo	ollows:

For accomplishing the purposes of this act, said the water
district, through its trustees, without the necessity of a vote
of the inhabitants of said the district, is authorized to borrow
money, not exceeding \$350,000 \$2,000,000, for long terms and
temporarily, and to issue therefor the interest-bearing
negotiable bonds and notes of the district for the purpose of
refunding the indebtedness so created; of paying any necessary
expenses and liabilities incurred under the provisions of this
act, including the expenses incurred in the creation of the
district; in acquiring the aferesaid properties and franchises of
the Kingfield Water Company, by purchase or otherwise; of
securing sources of supply; taking water and land; paying
damages; laying pipes; constructing, maintaining and operating a
water system and making extensions, additions and improvements to
the same.
