IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Defer Municipal Duties Related to the Homestead Exemption.

(EMERGENCY)

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Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, under existing law, municipalities are currently
required to accept and process applications for the homestead
exemptions created by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 36,
chapter 105, subchapter IV-A; and

10 Whereas, that exemption has not yet been funded by the Legislature; and

Whereas, the acceptance and processing of applications is only necessary and productive if the exemption is funded; and

16 Whereas, a decision about funding the exemption will probably not occur until late in the present legislative session; 18 and

20 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 22 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 24 safety; now, therefore,

26 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

28 . 36 MRSA §679 is enacted to read:

30 **§679.** Duties deferred

32 Notwithstanding any other law, a municipality does not have any obligation or duty that is imposed by chapter 105, subchapter 34 IV-A on a municipality, including, but not limited to, the duty to accept and process applications for the exemption provided by 36 subchapter IV-A until such time as that exemption has been funded by the State.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 40 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill relieves municipalities of the duty to receive and 46 process applications for the homestead exemption until the exemption is funded by the State.
