HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 832, L.D. 1198, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Procedures of Local Boards of Appeal"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill extends the appeal period from 30 days to 45 days for appeals of local board of appeals decisions. The additional work load and administrative costs associated with a minimal number of new cases filed in Superior Court as a result of the extended appeal period will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
