COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 846, L.D. 1212, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Motor Vehicles"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 3 and 9.

Further amend the bill in section 11 in the indented paragraph in the next to the last line (page 5, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "18 x 18 inches" and inserting in its place the following: '~~18 x 18~~ 12 x 12 inches'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 13.

Further amend the bill in section 14 in subsection 2 in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 6, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "police" and inserting in its place the following: 'State Police'

Further amend the bill in section 14 in subsection 2 in the 2nd paragraph in the first line (page 6, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "police" and inserting in its place the following: 'State Police'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill makes changes to the laws governing motor vehicles. The additional work load and administrative costs

2 associated with a minimal number of new traffic and criminal
cases filed in District Court as a result of these changes will
4 be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial
Department.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

10 The bill proposed changes in several laws dealing with motor
vehicles. This amendment makes technical changes in the bill.
12 The amendment deletes sections of the bill dealing with the
registration of motor vehicles, the use of lights that are not
14 original equipment on motor vehicles and the fee charged for
school bus inspections. The amendment reduces the size of the
16 red flag required to be attached to an overlength load to be
consistent with federal regulations. The amendment changes a
18 reference from police officers to State Police officers and adds
a fiscal note to the bill.
