STATEMENT OF FACT

10 The bill proposed changes in several laws dealing with motor vehicles. This amendment makes technical changes in the bill. The amendment deletes sections of the bill dealing with the 12 registration of motor vehicles, the use of lights that are not original equipment on motor vehicles and the fee charged for 14 school bus inspections. The amendment reduces the size of the red flag required to be attached to an overlength load to be 16 consistent with federal regulations. The amendment changes a reference from police officers to State Police officers and adds 18 a fiscal note to the bill.
