STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Clarify the Duties of the Legal Staff of the Maine State Housing Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

30-A MRSA §4723, sub-§2, ¶F is enacted to read:

F. The Maine State Housing Authority shall have a general counsel and such other staff attorneys as the director determines necessary. The general counsel and any other staff attorneys may represent the authority or its staff in any proceeding, investigation or trial and perform other functions and duties normally performed by attorneys. The general counsel may not act in any other capacities or hold any other positions, including policy-making positions, within the authority.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill clarifies and limits the position of general counsel of the Maine State Housing Authority to the general legal duties of a general counsel in order to avoid conflicts of interest, which may arise if the general counsel were to act in other capacities or hold other positions within the authority.
