2	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
_	as emergencies; and
4 .	Whereas, the Maine Water Resources Management Board has
6	completed its finding; and
8	Whereas, these findings are complex and difficult to summarize; and
10	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
12	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
14	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
16	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22	§6305. Report; reporting deadline
24	The board shall submit a report summarizing its findings and recommendations, including any suggested legislation, to the
26	Legislature by January February 1, 1991.
28	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

34	This bill extends the deadline for reporting to the Legislature from January 1, 1991 to February 1, 1991 for the
