Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the first line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Sec. 2."

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill broadens the mental state element of criminal 34 mischief by adding the word "recklessly." The additional work load and administrative costs associated with a minimal number of 36 additional cases will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.

The appointment of court-appointed counsel for indigent 40 defendants who are charged with these crimes will result in costs 42 to the Judicial Department. A General Fund appropriation to the 42 Judicial Department may be necessary for the indigent defense 44 program once the cumulative effect of all legislation for which 44 court-appointed counsel for indigent defendants must be provided 45 is known.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 854, L.D. 1220

The Governor's proposed adjusted current services budget affects the indigent defense program by discontinuing appointment 2 of counsel for certain crimes.'

This amendment deletes section 1 of the bill regarding aggravated criminal mischief. It retains the amendment to the criminal mischief statute. Criminal mischief is a Class D crime and a lower standard of mental culpability is appropriate.
