This amendment deletes the provision that requires the Department of Education, for purposes of rating a school construction project, to treat the facilities and programs of the

Maine Central Institute as if they were the facilities and programs of Maine School Administrative District Number 53. It also clarifies that the State Board of Education is not bound by the minimum site size for school construction projects, but shall determine whether the site is adequate for the proposed building.
