This bill increases the cap on fees currently charged by the Board of Registration in Medicine for licenses and registrations of physicians and physician assistants. If the board raises its fees to the highest level available, an additional \$323,000 in dedicated revenue could be generated. The amount will depend on the fee schedule adopted by the board.

The bill also changes the licensing process of the Board of Osteopathic Examination and Registration to a 2-year licensing or renewal period and increases the cap on fees. This will result in a minor decrease in administrative burdens for board staff and a shift of revenue from fiscal year 1992-93 to fiscal year 1991-92. The amount of the shift can not be estimated at this time. If the board raises its fees to the highest level available an additional \$46,450 annually could be raised.'
