## An Act to Clarify the Definition of Beverage.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

32 MRSA §1862, sub-§1, as affected by PL 1989, c. 869, Pt. C, §12, is amended to read:

1. Beverage. "Beverage" means beer, ale or other drink produced by fermenting malt, spirits, wine, wine coolers, or soda er--nenearbenated--water, and all nonalcoholic carbonated or noncarbonated drinks in liquid form and intended for internal human consumption, except for milk and, dairy-derived products and noncarbonated water.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill clarifies that noncarbonated water or spring water 18 is not subject to the provisions of the returnable beverage container laws.
