The amendment clarifies that the prohibitions included in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6406, subsection 1, paragraph E pertain only to persons whose marine licenses are suspended for violations that occur on or after Title 12, section 6406, subsection 1, paragraph E takes effect.
