HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 457, L.D. 1233, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Suspension of Licenses by the Commissioner of Marine Resources"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6406, sub-§1, as repealed and replaced by PL 1989, c. 455, §1, is amended to read:

1. Prohibited acts. It shall-be is unlawful for any person whose license is under suspension to:

A. Engage in any licensed activity;

B. Give another person permission to raise, lift, transfer or possess lobster traps or cars marked with the suspended person's lobster and crab fishing license number or lobster traps with buoys that carry the color design on file with the suspended license; ~~ex~~

C. Assist a holder of a Class II lobster and crab fishing license as a crew member, ; or

E. For any violation occurring on or after the effective date of this paragraph, assist any license holder as a crew member in any activity authorized by the suspended license.

Sec. 2. Applicability. The prohibitions in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6406, subsection 1, paragraph E do not apply to persons whose licenses are suspended for violations occurring prior to the effective date of that paragraph.

6 This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment clarifies  
8 that the prohibitions included in the Maine Revised Statutes,  
10 Title 12, section 6406, subsection 1, paragraph E pertain only to  
12 persons whose marine licenses are suspended for violations that  
E takes effect.
