HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 466, L.D. 1249, Bill, "An Act
Relating to the Education of Homeless Students"

Amend the bill by adding at the end before the statement of
fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill authorizes the Department of Education to adopt
rules that permit homeless students to enroll in the school
administrative units that best serve the students' needs. The
costs associated with rulemaking can be absorbed within existing
resources of the Department of Education. There will be no net
impact to General Purpose Aid to Local Schools related to the
choice of school administrative units.'
