An Act to Provide Union Security Rights for Municipal Public Employees.



2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 26 MRSA §963, as enacted by PL 1969, c. 424, §1, is amended
by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

6 A public employer and a public employee may provide in their
8 collective bargaining agreement for union security in the form of
a union shop, agency shop or fair share arrangement.

10 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

12 This bill authorizes municipalities and municipal workers
14 represented by their unions to enter into union security
arrangements.
