Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3.


Further amend the amendment in the fiscal note by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph (page 3, lines 47 to 51 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Costs associated with expenses of the Integrated Pest Management Advisory Committee will be absorbed by the Department of Agriculture utilizing existing budgeted resources.'
