HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 878,
L.D. 1269, Bill, "An Act to Notify the Probation Officer and the
Probationer When a Motion Is Filed to Terminate Probation at a
Time Earlier Than That Provided for in the Sentence"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the
title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place
the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in
its place the following:

'17-A MRSA §1202, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 499, §1,
is amended to read:

3. On application of the probation officer, or of the
person on probation, or on its own motion, the court may
terminate a period of probation and discharge the convicted
person at any time earlier than that provided in the sentence
made pursuant to subsection 1, if warranted by the conduct of
such person. A termination and discharge may not be ordered upon
the motion of the person on probation unless notice of the motion
is given to the probation officer by the person on probation.
Such termination and discharge shall serve to relieve the person
on probation of any obligations imposed by the sentence of
probation.' '

6 This amendment replaces the committee amendment. It
requires that a person on probation notify that person's
probation officer prior to the court order of termination and
8 discharge of probation.
