Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

25 MRSA §2808, sub-§1, ¶C, as repealed and replaced by PL  
1989, c. 454, is amended to read:

C. The term "training costs" includes the following:

(1) The full cost of the salary paid to the officer  
while in training;

(2) The full cost of the tuition charged by the Maine  
Criminal Justice Academy;

(3) The full cost of uniforms provided to the officer  
in training; and

(4) The full cost of the salary, ~~exclusive~~ inclusive  
of overtime, paid to officers previously or newly  
employed by the municipality to provide police  
protection that would otherwise have been lost during  
the absence of the officer in training.
