COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 897, L.D. 1294, Bill, "An Act to Improve the Smoke Detector Laws"

16 Amend the bill in subsection 7 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 11 and 12 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'The detector must be immediately 18 reconnected at the cessation of construction or rehabilitation 20 activities each day, regardless of the intent to return to construction or rehabilitation activities on succeeding days.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

26 The bill prohibits persons from disconnecting smoke detectors, but permits disconnection during construction work.

The amendment clarifies that smoke detectors must be reconnected at the end of each day of construction, even if construction work will continue on succeeding days.
