COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 898, L.D. 1295, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Time for Taking an Appeal by the State from the Juvenile Court to the Superior Court"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Clarify the Time for Taking an Appeal from the Juvenile Court to the Superior Court'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill authorizes the Supreme Judicial Court to extend the time period in which an appeal from Juvenile Court to Superior Court must be taken. The additional work load and administrative costs associated with a minimal number of additional appeals filed will be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects the title of the bill to more accurately reflect the statute being amended and adds a fiscal note.
