COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 912, L.D. 1309, Bill, "An Act to Provide for Changes to the Membership of the Electricians' Examining Board"

Amend the bill in the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting at the beginning the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§1151." in the 2nd paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "8" and inserting in its place the following: '7'

Further amend the bill in that part designated "§1151." in the 2nd paragraph in the 8th line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "3" and inserting in its place the following: '2'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.

This bill increases the membership of the Electricians' Examining Board from 6 to 7 members. The board will require additional allocations of \$1,420 in fiscal year 1991-92 and \$1,420 in fiscal year 1992-93 from existing balances of dedicated revenue for the per diem and expenses of the new board member.'
