Authorizing the Sale of Certain Public Lands"

Amend the resolve in the 2nd indented paragraph after the
title in the 4th line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting
after the following: "Maine" the following: '(hereinafter
referred to as the "Grantee")'

Further amend the resolve in subsection (3) in the 2nd line
(page 1, line 36 in L.D.) by striking out the following:
"\$1,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$1,500' and
in the next to the last line (page 1, line 38 in L.D.) by
striking out the following: "survey,"

Further amend the resolve in subsection (10) in the 3rd line
from the end (page 2, line 32 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "his" and inserting in its place the following: 'the
Grantee's'

Further amend the resolve in subsection (12) in the last 2
lines (page 2, lines 41 and 42 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "all amendments shall be in writing and executed by
the parties hereto" and inserting in its place the following:
'any amendments must be approved by the Legislature'

Further amend the resolve by inserting before the statement
of fact the following:

will increase dedicated revenue to the Public Reserve Lands

18 This amendment changes the resolve to increase the sale
price of the property in question to \$1,500 and removes the
20 requirement for the land to be surveyed. The amendment also
defines the term "Grantee" and requires any changes in this
22 agreement to be approved by the Legislature. The amendment also
adds a fiscal note.
