34	The original bill amended an existing section of law to reduce the terms of members of the State Board of Licensure for
36	Professional Foresters from 5 to 3 years. In a technical error, the bill stated that this was to take effect with the effective
38	date of the section. This amendment provides for a correct transition provision.
